Your Barrister has now reviewed your medical evidence and confirms that he still believes your case to carry sufficient prospects of success to issue proceedings and has now drafted the formal court documents in order to do so.

These documents are known as the Particulars of Claim. This is a formal court document and must be accurate. You must sign the statement of truth at the end of the document so long as the details are accurate.

If you sign the documents knowing that any of the information is false, the Court may find you guilty of contempt of Court. This is obviously an extremely serious matter. Please read the forms carefully before signing them. If any amendments need to be made, please tell us immediately and return the forms unsigned.

Please also make sure that all the items you want to claim for are referred to in the Particulars of Claim. Should there be any other expenses you wish to claim for as a direct result of your arrest you must notify me immediately as there may not be a chance to include them at a later date.

If you sign and return the Particulars of Claim, I will consider this to be confirmation that:

1. The contents are accurate;
2. You have no other items you want to claim

The details of how this claim is funded were of course explained to you at the outset of this claim however, once the matter turns litigated, there are potential cost consequences involved.
